Eligibility & Criteria

Eligible recipients are AMSCA members, their spouse, children, grandchildren, nieces, and nephews (extended families to the second generation).

Students must have completed two years of undergraduate school OR are participating in a graduate school program before applying for the grant.

The student may use the grant as needed for their personal use while a student (examples could include books, rent, food costs, etc.).

Submission Timeline

- You may submit applications throughout the year.
- Applications received by **Nov 1st** will be considered for the Spring Semester.
- Applications received by **May 1st** will be considered by the Fall Semester.

Application Process

AMSCA Family Grant Program

In 2017, the Army Medical Specialist Corps Association's Board of Directors approved the establishment of a new educational grant program designed for the members of the Army Medical Specialist Corps Association, their families, and their extended families to the second generation. The AMSCA Family Grant provides funds (up to \$500) to support eligible college students.

The first grant was awarded in the fall of 2020. Three grants were awarded in the fall of 2021. AMSCA budgets for three grants annually and may consider additional requests.

1. The AMSCA member will initiate the application using the form in this brochure.
2. The AMSCA member will also provide a written recommendation for the proposed recipient of the AMSCA Family Grant. The recommendation will include:
 - o The applicant's relationship to the member
 - o The type of degree sought, and the number of semester hours successfully completed so far
3. In addition, the proposed recipient/student will submit an essay describing their educational goals and a description of his/her financial needs.
